

HOMEWORK TOPIC PROJECT – RECORD BREAKERS

This half term's homework theme is record breakers. Choose from the selection of activities suggested below. The aim is to complete at least one task per week (you can do more if you wish. There are a mixture of practical and recorded tasks from which to choose. The aim is to be as creative as possible. These are just a few ideas. You could think of your own activities to do. For example you could keep a scrap book, write diary entries, complete drawings or do art work.

You have this half term to complete your project. The deadline date for handing everything in will be: **Monday 10th July 2017**.

Creative Literacy:

- Creating a reading record of the most books you have read between now and the deadline.
- Find out about Olympic record breakers e.g. Usain Bolt.
- Make a powerpoint about the biggest buildings in the world
- Create a scrap book about the smallest animals in the world compared to the biggest animals in the world.
- Presentation about the longest serving Queen.
- Research and write about the youngest inventor or even the oldest.

Spellings:

- How many new words can you spell? Write them down and get someone at home to test you.

Maths:

- Plant some seeds and track its progress using a bar chart. How big can you grow your plant?
- Measure the people in your family. Who is the tallest? Who is the shortest? What way can you present your information?

Reading:

- Continue to read a selection of books. Once you are familiar with a character write a short story about a character breaking a world record!
